Things to do Near the Beach House Hotel Half Moon Bay

1. Take a drive and visit two world famous lighthouses—**Pigeon Point Lighthouse**, 20 miles south of Half Moon Bay, and **Point Montara Lighthouse**, three miles north of the hotel. www.parks.ca.gov
2. Stroll **Historic Main Street** and visit the boutiques, restaurants, bakeries and cafes.
3. **Beach House** is located on the seven mile **Coastside Trail** that extends into Half Moon Bay. Hike, walk or bike along the dramatic ocean bluffs. Bike rentals available at **Bike Works**. 650.726.6708 | hello@bikeworkshmb.com
4. Enjoy live concerts of principally jazz, classical and world music at the **Bach Dancing and Dynamite Society** in Miramar Beach. 650.726.4143 | info@bachddsoc.org
5. Mountain bike or hike the **Montara Mountain Trail**. Hike **Purissima Creek Trail** through the majestic redwood groves to the year-round creek at the **Purissima Redwood Preserve**.
6. **Fitzgerald Marine Reserve**, accessed from Moss Beach, is a great place for tide pool exploration. 650.728.3584 | fitzgeraldreserve.org
7. Start a family tradition by visiting Half Moon Bay for our famous **Pumpkin Festival** in October or the **Night of Lights** on Main Street in December.
8. Discover the world of **Sea Kayaking** or **Stand up Paddle boarding** at **Half Moon Bay Kayak Company**. Just a five minute walk from the hotel offering beginner courses in the protected harbor. 650.773.6101 | www.hmbkayak.com
9. **Half Moon Bay Glass Blowing**: Learn to work with hot molten glass and make your own glass pumpkin, heart or paperweight. Located on Hwy 92 at the La Nebbia Winery. 650.283.5626 | www.hmbartglass.com
10. **Horseback riding on the Beach**. Enjoy rides from one to two hours. Rides go from the Coastal equestrian trail down to the beach. 650.726.2362 | www.seahorseranch.org
11. From fine oils to photography, local galleries offer something for everyone.
12. Visit **Pillar Point Harbor** for the fresh catch of the day right off of the boat, including seasonal crab, salmon and halibut. harbormaster@smharbor.com
13. Visit **Año Nuevo State Reserve** to watch the elephant seals in their natural habitat from December—March. Reservations required. 650.879.0227
14. Discover the Pescadero tradition of visiting **Harley Farms Goat Dairy** featuring an edible flower garden and tours of their cheese making room. 650.879.0480 | contactus@harleyfarms.com
15. **Bird Watching**. Half Moon Bay has wetland and natural preserves that create an inviting environment for more than 200 species of birds. Two perfect locations are the Pillar Point Marsh and the Pescadero Marsh Natural Preserve.
16. See the Big Kahunas surf at **Maverick's** famous big wave surf break. December—March.
17. Visit **La Nebbia Winery** for wine tasting and bocce ball one mile from downtown Half Moon Bay. 650.726.9463
18. Take advantage of the fresh local produce available at the Coastside Farmers Market located in Half Moon Bay. The Market is on Saturday's only from May—November.
19. Tee off at **Half Moon Bay Golf Links**, featuring two award winning 18-hole championship golf courses overlooking the Pacific Ocean. 650.726.4438 www.halfmoonbaygolf.com
